13 assorted $14 \times 20 \mathrm{~mm}$ resin bicones
6 assorted 18 mm resin rings
6 assorted $23 \times 31 \mathrm{~mm}$ resin teardrops
6 sterling silver 12 mm flower links
6 sterling silver $21 \times 32 \mathrm{~mm}$ flat oval and/or 27.5 mm flat circle components
12 sterling silver 9 mm jump rings 66 " of sterling silver 22-gauge wire

## TOOLS

Wire cutters
Chain-nose pliers
Round-nose pliers

## FINISHED SIZE: 42"

1: Use 6" of wire to form a wrapped loop that attaches to 1 component. String 1 crystal,


1 resin bicone, and 1 crystal; form a large oval wrapped loop (about $8 \times 15 \mathrm{~mm}$ ) that attaches to the wide end of 1 resin teardrop. 2: Use 4" of wire to form a wrapped loop that attaches to the hole in the previous teardrop. String 1 crystal, 1 resin bicone, and 1 crystal; form a wrapped loop.
3: Use 1 jump ring to attach the previous wrapped loop to 1 resin ring. Use 1 jump ring to attach 1 flower link to the same resin ring.
4: Use 6" of wire to form a wrapped loop that attaches to the previous flower link. String 1 crystal, 1 resin bicone, and 1 crystal; form a large oval wrapped loop that attaches to the wide end of 1 resin teardrop.
5: Use 4" of wire to form a wrapped loop that attaches to the hole in the previous resin teardrop. String 1 crystal, 1 resin bicone, and 1 crystal; form a wrapped loop that attaches to 1 component.
6: Use 1 jump ring to attach the previous component to 1 resin ring. Use 1 jump ring to attach 1 flower link to the same resin ring. 7: Use 4" of wire to form a wrapped loop that attaches to the previous flower link. String 1 crystal, 1 resin bicone, and 1 crystal; form a wrapped loop that attaches to the hole of 1 resin teardrop.
8: Use 6" of wire to form a large oval wrapped loop that attaches to the wide end of the previous resin teardrop. String 1 crystal, 1 resin bicone, and 1 crystal; form a wrapped loop that attaches to 1 component.
9: Repeat Steps 6-8 twice.
10: Use 4 " of wire to form a wrapped loop that attaches to the previous component. String 1 crystal, 1 resin bicone, and 1 crystal; form a wrapped loop that attaches to 1 flower link.
11: Use 1 jump ring to attach the previous flower link to 1 resin ring. Use 1 jump ring to attach 1 component to the same resin ring.
12: Repeat Step 1, using the previous component. Repeat Step 2, attaching the second wrapped loop to 1 flower link.
13: Repeat Step 11, attaching the second jump ring to the component used in Step 1. ©

## MATERIALS

6 opaque pink 3 mm fire-polished rounds
2 green $8 \times 5 \mathrm{~mm}$ fire-polished rondelles
3 sky blue $8 \times 5 \mathrm{~mm}$ fire-polished rondelles
3 yellow $6 \times 5 \mathrm{~mm}$ pressed-glass flowers
3 teal $9 \times 6 \mathrm{~mm}$ pressed-glass flowers
3 olive $9 \times 6 \mathrm{~mm}$ pressed-glass flowers
3 ivory-and-green $9 \times 6 \mathrm{~mm}$ pressed-glass flowers
6 red $12 \times 9 \mathrm{~mm}$ pressed-glass bellflowers
1 multicolored $21 \times 14 \mathrm{~mm}$ polymer clay chickadee pendant
1 brass 15 mm lie detector charm
1 brass $7 \times 15 \mathrm{~mm}$ tiny hinged box (with two 6 mm beads inside)
2 red $15 \times 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ vintage enameled metal flowers
3 pink $16 \times 5 \mathrm{~mm}$ vintage enameled metal flowers
6 brass $17 \times 23 \mathrm{~mm}$ filigree teardrops
6 vintage decorative head pins with green
$8 \times 18 \mathrm{~mm}$ teardrops
1 brass 11 mm spring-ring clasp
23 antique brass $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ head pins
1 brass 4 mm jump ring
10 brass 6 mm jump rings
1 brass 9 mm jump ring
$61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ of brass $9 \times 10 \mathrm{~mm}$ double curb chain

## TOOLS

Chain-nose pliers Round-nose pliers Wire cutters

FINISHED SIZE: 7"


1: Attach the 4 mm jump ring to the chickadee pendant. Use the 9 mm jump ring to attach the 4 mm jump ring to the middle link of the chain. Use 1 head pin to string 1 sky blue rondelle and 1 pink enamel flower; form a wrapped loop that attaches to the same chain link. Note that in the following steps charms are added from the center of the chain to the right end first, then from the center to the left end. 2: Use 1 decorative head pin to form a wrapped loop that attaches to the chain 1 link to the right of the pendant.
3: Use 1 brass head pin to string 1 teal flower; form a wrapped loop that attaches to the next chain link; repeat with 1 yellow flower and the same chain link. Use 1 brass head pin to string 1 pink round and 1 red bellflower; form a wrapped loop that attaches to the same chain link.
4: Repeat Step 2, attaching the wrapped loop to the next chain link. Use 1 brass head pin to string 1 green rondelle and 1 red enamel flower; form a wrapped loop that attaches to the same chain link.
5: Use 1 brass head pin to string 1 ivory-and-green flower; form a wrapped loop that attaches to the next chain link; repeat with 1 olive flower and the same chain link. Use 1 brass head pin to string 1 pink round and 1 red bellflower; form a wrapped loop that attaches to the same chain link.
6: Use one 6 mm jump ring to attach the lie detector charm to the next chain link. Use 1 brass head pin to string 1 sky blue rondelle and 1 pink enamel flower; form a wrapped loop that attaches to the same chain link.

7: Repeat Step 2, attaching the wrapped loop to the next chain link.
8: Repeat Step 3.
9: Use two 6 mm jump rings to attach the clasp to the last chain link on this side of the bracelet.
10: Repeat Step 2, attaching the wrapped loop to the chain link to the left of the pendant. Repeat Step 5. Repeat Step 4. Repeat Step 3. Repeat Step 6, using the hinged box. Repeat Step 7. Repeat Step 5.
11: Use the remaining 6 mm jump rings to attach the 6 brass filigree teardrops evenly along the bracelet. ©

## MATERIALS

5 clear-and-navy 9 mm glass rounds
6 light green $8 \times 12 \mathrm{~mm}$ vintage pressed-glass pear beads
2 aqua $12 \times 18 \mathrm{~mm}$ vintage pressed-glass petals
4 clear 13 mm vintage Lucite rounds
23 vintage finished dangles with bright blue 5 mm glass rounds and simple loops
1 sterling silver $14 \times 28 \mathrm{~mm}$ flower-and-leaf hook-and-eye clasp
2 natural brass $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ head pins
2 sterling silver 2 mm crimp tubes
9 " of .019 beading wire

Flat-nose pliers
Round-rose pliers
Wire cutters
Crimping pliers
FINISHED SIZE: 8"


If you can't find finished vintage dangles, make your own: use 1 brass $1^{1 "}$ head pin to string 1 round and form a simple loop.

1: Use 1 head pin to string 1 pear bead; form a wrapped loop. Repeat for a second pear dangle.
2: Use the beading wire to string 1 crimp tube and one half of the clasp; pass back through the tube and crimp. String 3 blue dangles, 1 pear bead (wide end first), and 3 blue dangles. String $\{1$ glass round and 1 Lucite round\} four times. String 1 glass round, 1 blue dangle, 1 petal, 2 blue dangles, 1 petal, and 3 blue dangles. String $\{1$ pear bead (narrow end first), 2 blue dangles, 1 pear dangle, and 2 blue dangles\} twice. String 1 pear bead (narrow end first), 3 blue dangles, 1 crimp tube, and the other half of the clasp; pass back through the tube and crimp. ©

## CANDY CHARM BRACELET

## MATERIALS

7 colorful $12-15 \mathrm{~mm}$ assorted lampworked rounds
7 colorful $15-20 \mathrm{~mm}$ assorted ceramic rounds, cones, and cylinders
3 colorful 20 mm assorted ceramic flat tabs
34 silver-plated 4 mm rounds 1 sterling silver 16 mm toggle clasp 14 sterling silver $2^{\prime \prime}$ head pins 2 sterling silver 6 mm jump rings 4 " of sterling silver
$4 \times 6 \mathrm{~mm}$ oval chain
12 " of sterling silver
20-gauge wire
TOOLS
Wire cutters
Round-nose pliers
Chain-nose pliers
FINISHED SIZE: 8"

1: Use 1 jump ring to attach one end of one $3 / 4$ " piece of chain to one half of the clasp.
2: Use 4" of wire to form a wrapped loop that attaches to the free end of the previous chain. String 1 silver round, one 20 mm ceramic tab, and 1 silver round; form a wrapped loop that attaches to one end of one $3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ piece of chain.
3: Repeat Step 2 twice. Use 1 jump ring to attach the free end of the previous chain to the other half of the clasp.
4: Use 1 head pin to string 1 silver round, one $15-20 \mathrm{~mm}$ ceramic bead or 1 lampworked bead, and 1 silver round; form a wrapped loop that attaches to a link of the first piece of chain used in Step 1.
5: Repeat Step 4 twice to attach 2 more dangles to the same piece of chain.
6: Repeat Step 4 four times, attaching 4 dangles to the next piece of chain. Repeat entire step, attaching the dangles to the next piece of chain.
7: Repeat Step 4 three times, attaching the dangles to the next (and final) piece of chain. $\odot$
