Linking rings bail

Size 11° or 15° Delicas (A)
Size 8° Delica beads (B)
4mm round SWAROVSKI ELEMENTS (C)
Metal rings or other ring components

Bonded beading thread
Beading needle
Scissors

Make the ladder strip

1. Using a 3' length of thread create a snug ladder of B (Figure 1). Leave a 6" tail. Make the ladder long enough to wrap around the two rings being linked, but do not attach the ends of the ladder yet. Exit the last B in the ladder.

Add embellishment picots

2. String 1C and 1A. Pass back through the C and through the B. Pull the thread so the C and A are snug to the B.

3. String 1C and 1A. Pass back through the C and the B. Pull the thread so the C and A are snug to the B.

4. Pass through the next B in the ladder without adding the picot (Figure 2).

5. Repeat Steps 2–4 to add crystal picots along both edges of the ladder. There should be a picot on either end of every size 8°.

Connect the ends of the ladder

6. Bring the ends of the ladder through the two rings being linked. Work in ladder stitch to connect the first and last B beads. Knot the working thread and tail to secure the embellished strip into a loop (Figure 3). Weave in the ends and trim.

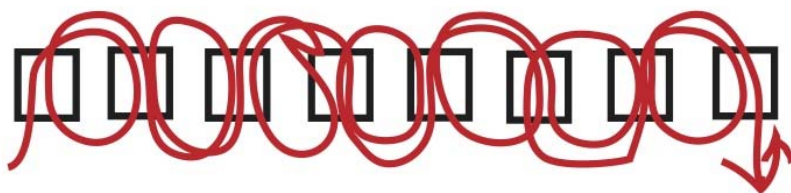

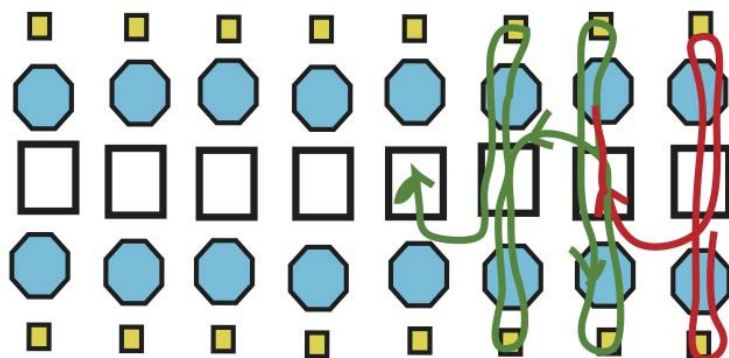

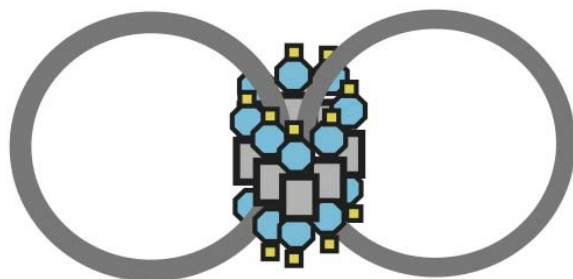
