Use a Katiedids[™] Creative Component bezel to create an easy, personalized necklace.

First, pass a head pin through the hole at the top of the bezel and make a wrapped loop to attach it to a bail. Next, choose your image and glue it to the back of an acrylic dome using dimensional glaze. String seed beads onto a piece of beading wire and cross the wire ends inside the last few beads to make a beaded ring. Glue the image and beaded ring into place using dimensional glaze. Now, the pendant onto the center of your necklace and add beads as desired to the necklace wires!
