KRISTAL WICK:

Non-Traditional Pearl Knots

STEPS:

1. Cut 4' strips of 6mm WireLace (chocolate). 18 strips total.
2. String pearl, tie WL, string pearl, tie WL onto neck wire until complete.
3. Tszuj the WL (pull waves on each side of the strip).

PART II

1. Cut 20 inches 0.18 copper wire.
2. Crimp on one side leaving a small loop on the end.
3. String silver pearl, tie WL, string silver pearl. Continue until strand is long enough to drape under the neck wire.
4. Crimp other end leaving a small loop on the end.
5. Slide each small loop onto neck wire. Add bell end caps to wire.
