KRISTAL WICK:

Non-Traditional Pearl Knots

STEPS:

- 1. Cut 4' strips of 6mm WireLace (chocolate). 18 strips total.
- 2. String pearl, tie WL, string pearl, tie WL onto neck wire until complete.
- 3. Tszuj the WL (pull waves on each side of the strip).

PART II

- 1. Cut 20 inches 0.18 copper wire.
- 2. Crimp on one side leaving a small loop on the end.
- 3. String silver pearl, tie WL, string silver pearl. Continue until strand is long enough to drape under the neck wire.
- 4. Crimp other end leaving a small loop on the end.
- 5. Slide each small loop onto neck wire. Add bell end caps to wire.
