Step Outs for Flower Pin Back Pendant Beads Baubles and Jewels



MATERIALS NEEDED

Claudine Hellmuth Studio Sticky Back Canvas in Natural
Claudine Hellmuth Studio Creative Layers Foam Stamps in Bloom
Claudine Hellmuth Studio Paints in Modern Red
Claudine Hellmuth Studio Multi Medium in matte

Xacto knife
Button
Tulle
Pin back

Scissors

INSTRUCTIONS

Stamp Bloom circle foam stamp twice onto Natural Sticky Back Canvas using Claudine Hellmuth Studio paint in Modern Red.

Allow to dry.

Cut circles out.

Fray edges of circles using an xacto knife.

Print text onto a piece of 8.5x11 then tear into ¼" strips by first making a small cut then tearing the canvas the rest of the way.

Take on strip of the print Sticky Back Canvas and wrap and fold it around the center of the circle to create a rolled flower look.

Add a second strip to make your flower larger.

Add Multi Medium to any places where the flower needs to be secured.

Cut tulle into a circle that is about ½" larger than the canvas circles. Fold tulle and cut center out so that it makes a doughnut shape.

Peel paper backing off the canvas circle with the flower and then stick the tulle to the adhesive backing.

Heat the tulle with a heat gun to make it shrink and curl.

Add the pin back to the second circle by cutting holes in the back of the circle and treading the pin back through.

Remove the paper backing and then apply to the back of the circle with the flower on it.

Cut leaves from the left over printed canvas and insert between the two circles.

Add a button or gems in the center using Mutli Medium as a finishing touch.
