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## **GLITTERATI SEGMENT KRISTAL WICK**

Kristal Wick combines crushed German glass glitter with resin to create sparkly heart earrings using antique-style locket frames. She shows how to mix-in a variety of small metal beads for a look that you'll love.

### **Materials needed**

2 Heart frames  
Resin (Gel du Soleil)  
Resin UV lamp  
Glitter (Martha Stewart Glitter)  
2 head pins  
2 earwires  
2 filigrees  
8 spacers  
2 gold beads  
2-4mm fuchsia crystal bicones  
2-5mm fuchsia crystal butterflies

### **Tools**

Wire cutter  
Round nose pliers  
Chain nose pliers  
Tweezers  
Toothpicks

### **Instructions**

1. Pour thin layer of resin in heart.
2. Sprinkle glitter on resin.

3. Scoot glitter into resin with toothpick if needed.
4. Cure in lamp.
5. \*Add another drop of resin and cure to get the dome effect.
6. Create dangle by stringing spacer, gold bead, spacer, butterfly, spacer, 4mm crystal, spacer onto headpin.
7. Make a small simple loop at the top of the headpin.
8. Attach dangle to filigree loop.
9. Attach filigree to heart with a jumpring.
10. Add earwire.
