Instructions:

1. Using two sets of needle nose pliers, separate the chain into (2) $5 \frac{1}{2} /{ }_{2}$ " lengths.
2. Using 6 mm jump rings, attach a toggle clasp end to each chain.
3. Cut the following lengths of beading wire: (2) $10^{\prime \prime}$, (2) $12^{\prime \prime}$, (2) $14^{\prime \prime}$, (2) $16^{\prime \prime}$ and (2) $18^{\prime \prime}$.
4. Using crimp tubes, attach each beading wire length to its own 6 mm jump ring. Attach the jump rings by strand length to one of the $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " chains.
Thread the bead pattern onto the strands, the patterns are as follows:
strand $1=6$ purple, 6 blue, 5 green, 6 blue and 6 purple;
strand $2=6$ purple, 6 blue, 6 green, 6 blue and 6 purple;
strand $3=6$ purple, 6 blue, 8 green, 6 blue and 6 purple;
strand $4=6$ purple, 6 blue, 10 green, 6 blue and 6 purple;
strand $5=6$ purple, 6 blue, 12 green, 6 blue and 6 purple;
strand $6=6$ purple, 6 blue, 14 green, 6 blue and 6 purple;
strand $7=6$ purple, 6 blue, 16 green, 6 blue and 6 purple;
strand $8=6$ purple, 6 blue, 18 green, 6 blue and 6 purple;
strand $9=6$ purple, 6 blue, 20 green, 6 blue and 6 purple;
strand $10=6$ purple, 6 blue, 22 green, 6 blue and 6 purple.
5. Use crimp tubes to attach each beaded wire to its own 6 mm jump ring. Attach the jump rings by strand length to the other $51 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ chain.
