Choose one birthstone bead for each of your children's birthdays:
January: Garnet
February: Amethyst/Onyx
March: Aquamarine/Bloodstone
April: Diamond/Crystal
May: Emerald
June: Pearl
July: Ruby
August: Peridot
September: Sapphire
October: Opal/Tourmaline
November: Citrine/Topaz
December: Turquoise

## Tools:

Round-nose pliers
Chain-nose pliers
Wire cutters

Level: Intermediate

Time: 15 minutes

Tip: If you don't want to make the larger wire wraps on your beads, just use head pins, which work well with top to bottom drilled beads and make a simple loop to attach to the ends of the chain dangles.

## Instructions:

1. Cut two 8 " pieces of chain, $12.5 "$ piece of chain, $11.5 "$ piece of chain and $11.25 "$ piece of chain.
2. Onto a jump ring slide final link of one 8 " piece of chain and the lobster clasp.
3. Connect a jump ring to the other 8 " piece of chain.
4. Thread the other ends of the 8 " pieces of chain followed by the three other pieces onto the third jump ring.
5. Make a wire wrapped loop through the crystal faceted teardrop, connecting the loop to the end of the 2.5 " piece of chain before wrapping it.
6. Repeat step 5 for the other two dangles with the other two beads.
