Make your own gorgeous Swarovski crystal earrings using the same settings that costume jewelry manufacturers use, but you get to choose your own crystal colors! Each of these earrings has a prong setting that's attached to a filigree, which allows you to further customize your earrings because you can add extra dangles and drops.

For the basic earring:

- 1. Place the pointed end of a crystal chaton (or back of a rivoli) inside the setting.
- 2. Use chain-nose pliers (or the cushioned handles) to bend the prongs down onto the surface to hold the crystal in place. Or, use a special hand-held tool to push down all of the prongs at once.

Ideas for embellishing the earring:

- To create a longer chandelier drop, use jump rings to attach short lengths of chain to the spaces on the filigree component. Add a beaded dangle for extra sparkle.
- String bicone crystals onto head pins and make wrapped or basic loops to attach them to the filigree component.

Variations:

You can also set other elements in the prong settings, such as crystal flowers, metalized flowers and pearl cabochons.
