


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Flat Memory Wire Tennis Bracelet

Materials:

6mm Cubic Zirconia (505Z-060) Square Cup Flat Memory Wire Finding (317B-452) Beadalon 2-Party Epoxy Glue (215A-100) Flat Memory Wire End Cap (317B-318) Flat Memory Wire Bracelet (347B-070)

Tools:

Memory Wire Shears (JTMEMCUT1)

Instructions:

- 1. Use Memory Wire Shears to cut a length of Flat Memory Wire Bracelet (347B-070).
- 2. Insert 6mm Cubic Zirconia (505Z-060) into the Square Cup Flat Memory Wire Finding (317B-452).
- 3. Use the side of a Bent Chain Nose Pliers to gently press one of the prongs down onto the stone.
- 4. Next, bend down the prong on the opposite side from the one that you just bent.



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- 5. Bend the remaining two prong to secure the stone in the finding.
- 6. Repeat steps 1-4 until all of your stones are set in the findings.
- 7. Mix up a batch of Beadalon 2-Party Epoxy Glue and use it to glue a Flat Memory Wire End Cap onto one end of the Flat Memory Wire Bracelet.
- 8. Thread the findings onto the Flat Memory Wire Bracelet until it is the correct length.
- 9. Glue a Flat Memory Wire End Cap onto the other end of the bracelet.

Variations:

- Use Round Cup Flat Memory Wire Findings (317B-450) with Swarovski SS30 Flatback Stones.
- Use a Magna-Tube Clasp (316B-292) instead of the Flat Memory Wire Ends.
- Design using flat back stones glued onto Flat Memory Wire Findings.
- Use the Memory Wire Finishing Pliers (201A-250) to Bend the ends of the Flat Memory Wire into a circle to finish off.
