## Silver Swing

Pearls, crystals, and silver beads spill out from two beautiful etched cones that are suspended from silver chain.


Step 1: Cut two 6" pieces of chain. Use 2" of 24-gauge wire to form a wrapped loop that attaches to one end of each chain. Repeat with the remaining 2 " of 24 -gauge wire and the other ends of the chains.
Step 2: Attach 8" of beading wire to one of the wrapped loops using a crimp tube. String 6 seed beads. String 1 amethyst 5 mm round, 1 topaz bicone, 2 amethyst 4 mm rounds, and 1 topaz. bicone six times. String 1 amethyst 5 mm round, 6 seed beads, 1 crimp tube, and the other wrapped loop. Pass back through the tube and crimp.
Step 3: Repeat Step 2, stringing 6 seed beads; 1 coin pearl and 1 rondelle ten times; 1 coin pearl and 6 seed beads.
Step 4: Repeat Step 2, stringing 6 seed beads; 1 Indian sapphire bicone and 1 curved fube six times; 1 Indian sapphire bicone and 6 seed beads.

## MATERIALS

60 silver size $11^{\circ}$ seed beads 12 amethyst 4 mm crystal rounds 19 light amethyst 4 mm crystal rounds 18 crystal shadow 4 mm crystal rounds 7 amethyst 5́mm crystal rounds 12 topàz AB 5 mm crystal bicones 7 Indian sapphire 5 mm crystal bicones
19 peacock 6 mm potato pearls
11 peacock 10 mm coin pearls
2 sterling silver $20 \times 22 \mathrm{~mm}$ etched cones
20 sterling silver 2 mm cornerless cubes
10 sterling silver 3 mm flower-printed rondelles
6 sterling silver $2 \times 20 \mathrm{~mm}$ curved tubes
1 sterling silver $12 \times 22 \mathrm{~mm}$ round box clasp
with pearl inlay
1 sterling silver 3 mm jump ring
1 sterling silver 4 mm jump ring
10 sterling silver 2 mm crimp tubes
22 " of sterling silver $3 \times 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ oval chain
4 " of sterling silver 24 -gauge wire
40 " of .019 beading wire

Step 5: Repeat Step 2, stringing 6 seed beads; 1 cornerless cube and 1 potato pearl nineteen times; 1 cornerless cube and 6 seed beads.
Step 6: Repeat Step 2, stringing 6 seed beads; 1 light amethyst round and 1 crystal shadow round eighteen times; 1 light amethyst round and 6 seed beads.
Step 7: Use one of the wrapped loop wires to string 1 cone; form a wrapped loop that attaches to one end of the remaining $10{ }^{\prime \prime}$ of chain. Attach the other end of the chain to one half of the clasp using the 4 mm jump ring.
Step 8: Use the other wrapped loop wire to string 1 cone; form a wrapped loop. Use the 3 mm jump ring to connect the wrapped loop to the other half of the clasp. ©
