## renaissance charm

The decorative fine silver rings and toggle used in this bracelet lend the piece a very romantic, Old World feel. But don't let the detail fool you-for all its charm, this bracelet is deceptively easy to make!


## materials

4 silk $6 \times 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ crystal rondelles
4 crystal golden shadow $8 \times 6 \mathrm{~mm}$ crystal rondelles
7 white 12 mm coin pearls
6 assorted $14-15 \mathrm{~mm}$ fine silver decorative rings
1 fine silver 23 mm decorative toggle clasp
15 brass 24 -gauge $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ head pins
9 brass 4 mm jump rings
6 brass 10 mm etched jump rings
$61 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ of brass $6 \times 11 \mathrm{~mm}$ etched oval chain

## T00LS

Wire cutters
Flat-nose pliers
Round-nose pliers

Finished size: 71/2"

1: Use one 4 mm jump ring to attach the bar half of the clasp to one end of the chain. Attach one 4 mm jump ring to the ring half of the clasp, then use another 4 mm jump ring to attach the previous 4 mm jump ring to the other end of the chain.

2: Use a head pin to string 1 silk crystal and form a wrapped loop that attaches to a link of the chain. Repeat with the remaining crystals and the coin pearls, attaching the wrapped loops in random order along the chain.

3: Use one 10 mm jump ring to attach 1 fine silver ring to a link of the chain; repeat twice.

4: Attach one 10 mm jump ring to one of the remaining fine silver rings. Attach one 4 mm jump ring to the 10 mm jump ring. Use another 4 mm jump ring to attach the previous 4 mm jump ring to a link of the chain. Repeat entire step twice.
