

# Renaissance Charm

The decorative fine silver rings and toggle used in this bracelet lend the piece a very romantic, Old World feel. But don't let the detail fool you—for all its charm, this bracelet is deceptively easy to make!



## MATERIALS

- 4 silk 6x4mm crystal rondelles
- 4 crystal golden shadow 8x6mm crystal rondelles
- 7 white 12mm coin pearls
- 6 assorted 14-15mm fine silver decorative rings
- 1 fine silver 23mm decorative toggle clasp
- 15 brass 24-gauge 1½" head pins
- 9 brass 4mm jump rings
- 6 brass 10mm etched jump rings
- 6¼" of brass 6x11mm etched oval chain

## TOOLS

- Wire cutters
- Flat-nose pliers
- Round-nose pliers

### Finished size: 7½"

**1:** Use one 4mm jump ring to attach the bar half of the clasp to one end of the chain. Attach one 4mm jump ring to the ring half of the clasp, then use another 4mm jump ring to attach the previous 4mm jump ring to the other end of the chain.

**2:** Use a head pin to string 1 silk crystal and form a wrapped loop that attaches to a link of the chain. Repeat with the remaining crystals and the coin pearls, attaching the wrapped loops in random order along the chain.

**3:** Use one 10mm jump ring to attach 1 fine silver ring to a link of the chain; repeat twice.

**4:** Attach one 10mm jump ring to one of the remaining fine silver rings. Attach one 4mm jump ring to the 10mm jump ring. Use another 4mm jump ring to attach the previous 4mm jump ring to a link of the chain. Repeat entire step twice. ■
